who is waiting for an autism assessment?

Looking for caregivers who are interested in participating in a semi self-paced video intervention for learning new ways of playing with their children. You will watch a series of videos and practice playing with your child, sharing your results with the researcher by video.

Caregiver Requirements: Internet access, video capabilities on a computer or tablet, infant and toddler toys, and a desire to play with your child!

Caregiver participants will receive financial compensation for their involvement.

Child requirements: 12-36 months old, not yet diagnosed with autism but referred for and waiting for an autism assessment.
